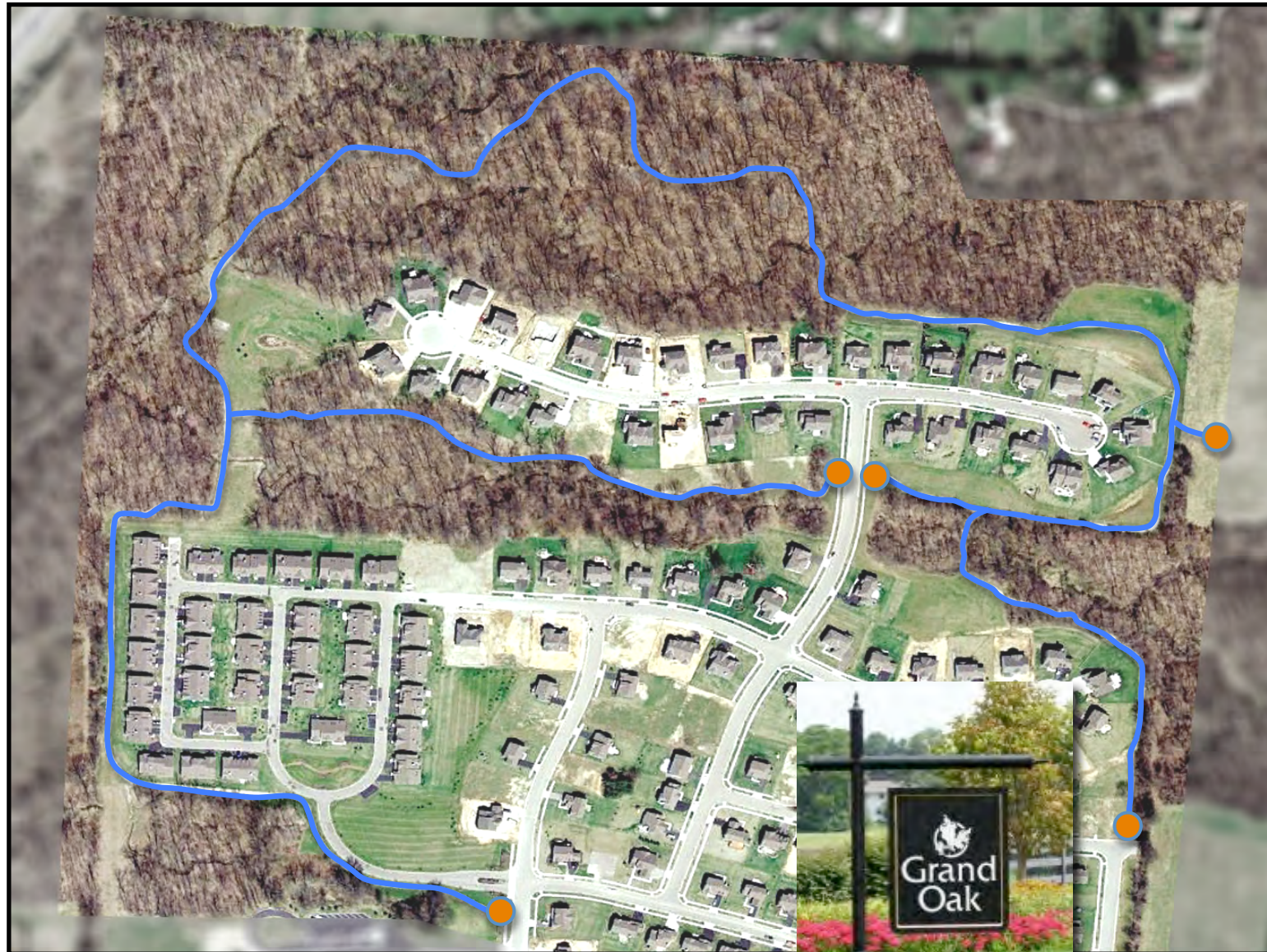

The wooded ravines and old growth forest in the area represent some of the last natural topography in the township. GTLCA is committed to work closely with all public officials to support its purpose and to encourage community participation in all preservation efforts.

The Grand Oak preserve features walking paths on 46 acres of beautiful, old-growth forest, with many large, mature trees, wooded ravines, creeks, wetlands, deer, small animals and birds.
